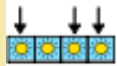
What Is a Harvest Festival?



A harvest festival is a celebration of the food grown on the land.



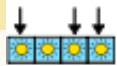
In Britain, harvest festivals are

in



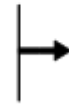

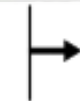

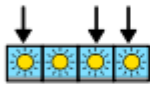

When Is Harvest Festival?



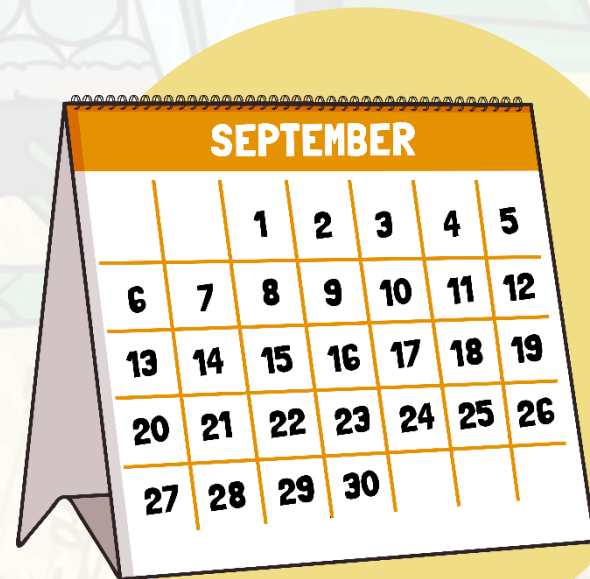
In Britain, harvest festivals

Before we can harvest our food, we need it to grow.





Spring

food begins to grow.





Summer

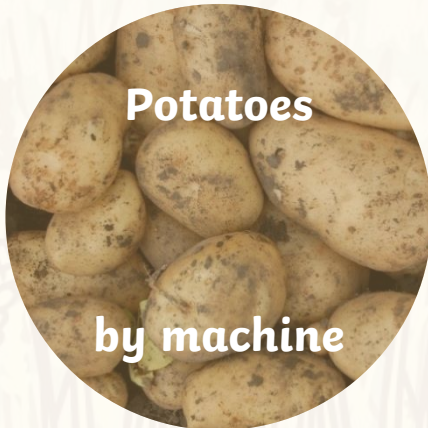
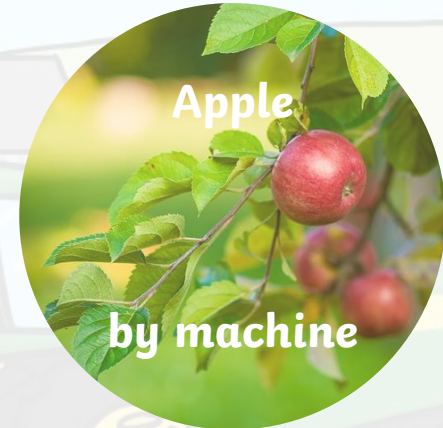
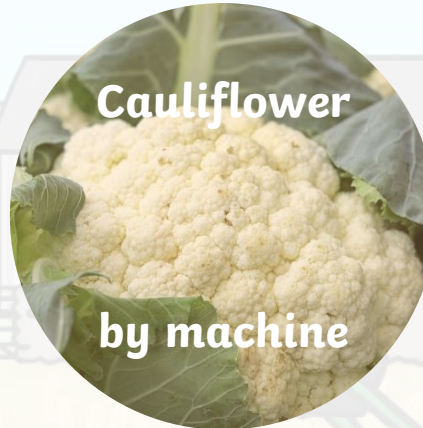
