Activity: Communication

- Life Skills Making Squash
- Experiment and play with liquids and a variety of beakers/containers.
- Use the symbol support task-list to give instructions to make a drink of squash. Work together to make a drink.

Resources: symbol support sheet, cups, squash, empty bottles, jugs, containers

Activity: Maths

• Life Skills – Making a Drink

- Use the terms full, empty, nearly full and nearly empty when making drinks at home.
- Practice pouring to a line by putting a mark around the cup with a pen or elastic band for the pupils to know how much to pour.

Resources: jug or bottle, glasses, plastic cups, elastic bands, preferred drink

Activity: Technology

- Use internet to search for Lion King or Aladdin songs. With support, pupils may be able to type Lion King songs or Aladdin songs into Google or you can search for them.
- After searching, get the pupils to choose a song to listen to, either by pointing or by using IT independently.

Activity: Music Appreciation

 Listen to music from Aladdin, Lion King or any other musicals. Use smiley face cards to express like or dislike or tell you what they think.

 After listening to a song from Aladdin or Lion King, listen to a music from Wales – Tom Jones, Stereophonics, Male Voice Choir, harp music or whatever you like!

Resources: Internet access via mobile phone, tablet or laptop.




Health and Wellbeing
