Swansea Liberty Stadium is the 3rd largest stadium in Wales.

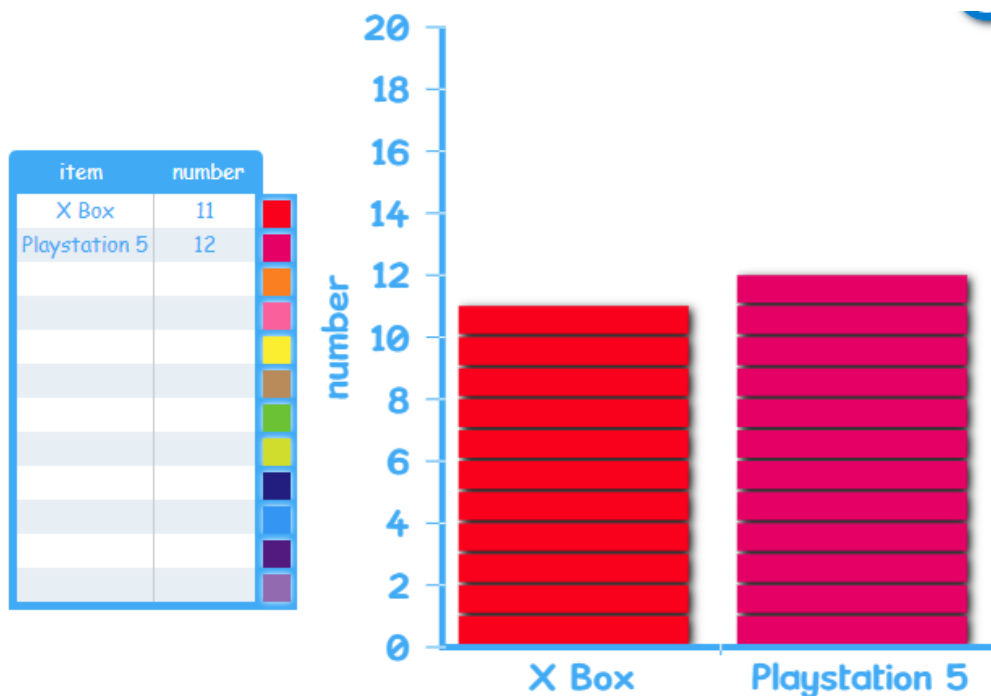
Swansea changed its logo for their merchandise and kits for the 2021/22 season. It has been 40 years since they won promotion to the first division in 1981.

I was lucky to be invited to a School Council meeting at the Penlan site to meet one of our School Governor's Mrs Williams.

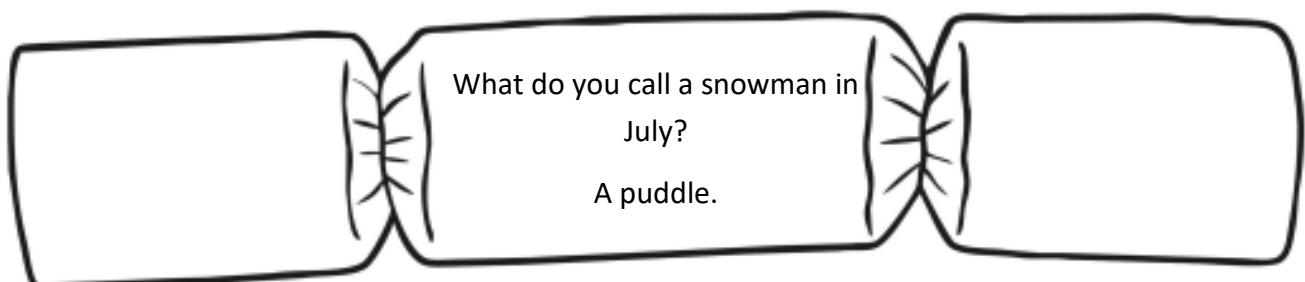
Mrs Williams is really interested in what we do at Pen y Bryn.
