By being given the opportunity we hope to increase confidence, self-esteem and well-being, leading to better emotional resilience to cope with the increasing need for independence in later life.

ENSPIR for 12-18's @ Gorseinon Evolve Youth Hub Friday Evening from 5pm—7pm (term time)

Enabled's Services Promoting Independence and Resilience (ENSPIR) for 12-18 year olds is funded by Swansea's Children and Young peoples fund and is for children with disabilities/additional needs.

The ENSPIR service is for children and young people with disabilities and mental health needs aged 12-18, to access social and leisure opportunities, have access to new experiences, grow in confidence, and to learn the valuable social and independence skills that they will need in adult life.

During sessions children will be able to have fun and make friends, while improving their communication, interaction and social skills. By being given the opportunity we hope to increase confidence, self-esteem and well-being, leading to better emotional resilience to cope with the increasing need for independence in later life.

The ENABLED Service 18-25's @ Gorseinon Evolve Youth Hub 2nd and 3rd Friday of the month from 7pm—9pm

ENABLED is a specialist service for 18-25 year old young people with additional needs/ disabilities. The focus of the service is to work with the young people to help them gain the independence skills and confidence to face the challenges of adult life.

During sessions the young people will be able to meet new people and make new friends, have a chance to chat about issues facing young people with disabilities and find ways together to overcome the barriers this presents; while improving interaction and social skills. They will also get the opportunity to learn independence skills have new experiences and broaden their knowledge of the world around them. By being given the opportunity, we hope to increase their confidence, self-esteem and well-being, leading to better emotional resilience to cope with the increasing need for independence in later life.

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Interplay's 4-11 Years Wellbeing Early Intervention Project Penlan Methodist Church Saturday 10am - 11.45am (term time)

JASC & SWAT Provision For children aged 6-18

The JASC and SWAT service provides support for children with an additional need/ disability to access mainstream provision that they have not been able to access previously.

Contact Interplay if you need short term support to access your local afterschool club, access out of school activities in their local area, or to access special interest or sports clubs, or even you local mainstream holiday scheme.

The SWAT worker will work with the child/ young person, staff at the local clubs and families to ensure that the child/young person gets the right support to be able to engage in activities.

Priority is given to children that currently attend Ysgol Crug Glas. This is an Interplay run service funded by Swansea's Children and Young peoples fund.
