I like listening to music when I'm running. Armin van Buren, The Class and Madness.



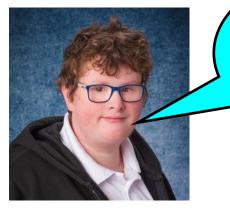

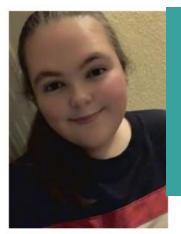
